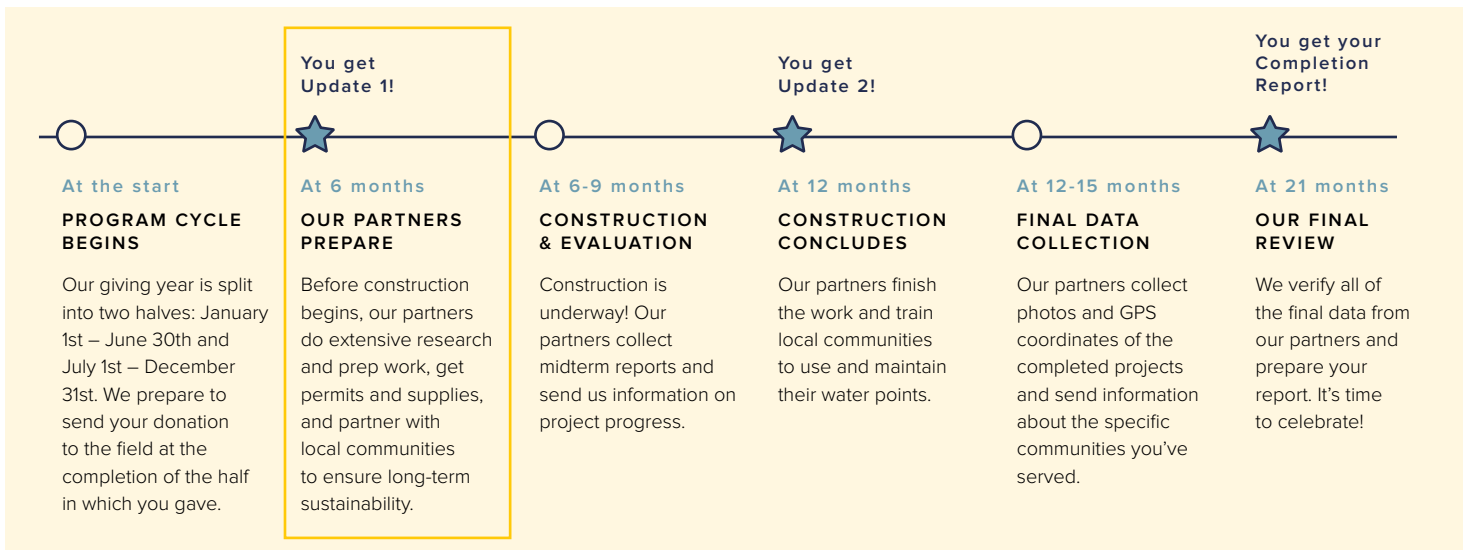

WHY MALAWI?

Malawi is one of Africa's most densely populated and least developed countries. Most people live in rural areas where water is scarce. As a result, many women and children spend hours of their day walking to collect it. Access to clean drinking water and improved sanitation drastically reduce the risk of water-related diseases and give hours of time back to women and children.

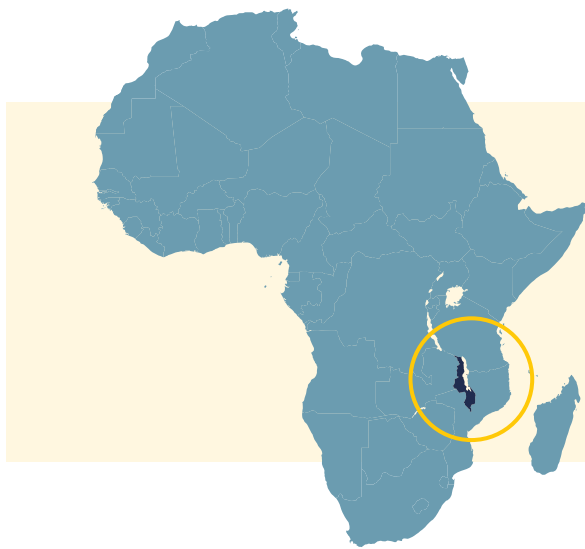

ABOUT WORLD VISION

World Vision Malawi aims to use WASH programs to reduce the prevalence of diarrhea among children under five. Together with local partners, they are constructing and rehabilitating boreholes, piped systems, and sanitary facilities to prevent waterborne diseases. World Vision's goal is for households to have year-round access to at least 20 liters of clean water per person, per day, from a protected water source within a 30-minute round-trip walk.
